OGH TEMPORARILY UPDATES VISITATION POLICY

TEMPORARY VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

In order to keep our patients, staff, and community safe we are temporarily limiting visitors due to the increase of illness.

Please follow these guidelines:

- ONLY 2 Visitors allowed.
- · No one under the age of 17 is permitted.
- You CANNOT visit if you have been sick in the last 2 weeks, have had vomiting or diarrhea, or have symptoms of a respiratory infection such as coughing, fever, or congestion.
- You must follow hospital protocol and use personal protection equipment such as mask, gown, and gloves when necessary.
- · Additional restrictions may apply.
- · Wash hands/use sanitizer before and after visiting



ospital administration has taken a proactive approach to limiting the spread of viruses to members of the community by temporarily updating the visitation policy to the hospital. Administration does not take this decision lightly and will review this policy as needed. Visitors need to check in at the nurses' station before entering patient areas. Signs in English and Spanish have been posted throughout the hospital.

At this time the restriction does not apply to OGH obstetrical patients; however, visitors must be in good health and not showing symptoms of sickness. It will be up to the Nurses' and Providers' discretion to allow/limit visitors. Any questions about this update may be directed to Scarlett Coombs, Infection Control Nurse, LVN, at 806-648-7114.

OGH has added a comprehensive panel test that can detect a variety of viruses so that patients can more accurately be treated. Make an appointment with your provider to receive an order for this testing, which is done at our OGH Laboratory. The test is a single-swab through the nostril, results are available within an hour.
